

What is PoLEN?







POLEN: Key Achievements

Successful advocacy initiative resulting in the passage of the Philippine Nursing Act (RA 9173) at the 15th Philippine Congress.



Republic Act. No. 9173 – The scope of nursing practice – roles, functions, responsibilities and activities which a registered nurse is educated, competent, and has the authority to perform.

Nursing Law Under SB 1447 or the Philippine Nursing Practice of 2022, The PROPOSED LEGISLATION introduces a new provision on the Advanced Practice Nurse (APN), an expanded and more collaborative role for qualified nurses to allow more efficient access to Universal Health Care for Filipinos. 11/10/2022.



Under SB an APN refers to a nurse who has acquired substantial level of theoretical knowledge and decision-making skill in a specialty area of nursing practice and demonstrated proficiency in clinical utilization of such knowledge and skill in providing expanded and collaborative expert care from a recognized higher educational institution, aside from being a board passer.

Nov. 4, 2022 approved Senate Bill.

Founder's Day Celebration Aug. 29, 2023 dedication ceremony. Memorabilia display of Dr. Luz Sobong-Porter's Life and naming of the Center.

Dr. Brian Porter (son of Dr. Luz Porter) is giving a sizable amount of donation to assist with COLEN initiative for 2023-2024. His company Novartis Pharmaceuticals also contributing to this.

Center of Leadership Excellence In Nursing (CoLEN)

Donation to be used to support the hiring of a qualified full-time COLEN Director. Two years end of 2023 and 2024 at \$25,000 per year.


The bulk of the donation will come from Dr. Brian's personal funds (\$20,000.00) and another \$5,000.00 to come directly from his employer, Novartis Pharmaceuticals.

Proposal – SU will provide at least 50% of the Director’s salary and the other 50% from his donation. Overtime SU should source an increasing portion of the Director’s salary. Awaiting approval by Pres.
