

Currently we have two co-directors of CoLEN, Dr. Evalyn E. Abalos and Jusie Lydia Siega-Sur.


- Colen workshops conducted and two research proposals for potential funding being finalized.
- Continues partnership with Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center, California Baptist University, the Sobong and Porter family, and the * Cgarities Aid Foundation of America, the charitable arm of Novartis.
- Through the efforts of Dr. Brian Porter, CoLEN has received partial donation in Dec. 2023 to help fund the salaries of the Chairpersons and other projects. He will continue to subsidize the additional funds before the end of 2024 or early in 2025. This donation is with a matching fund from Novartis. The total donation by the end of 2025 will be \$50,000.00. The University matches the funding for the salaries of the chairpersons. Hopefully, by the end of the two-year period CoLEN will be self sufficient.


